Responsible Design values quality materials that deliver both aesthetic and practical benefits.



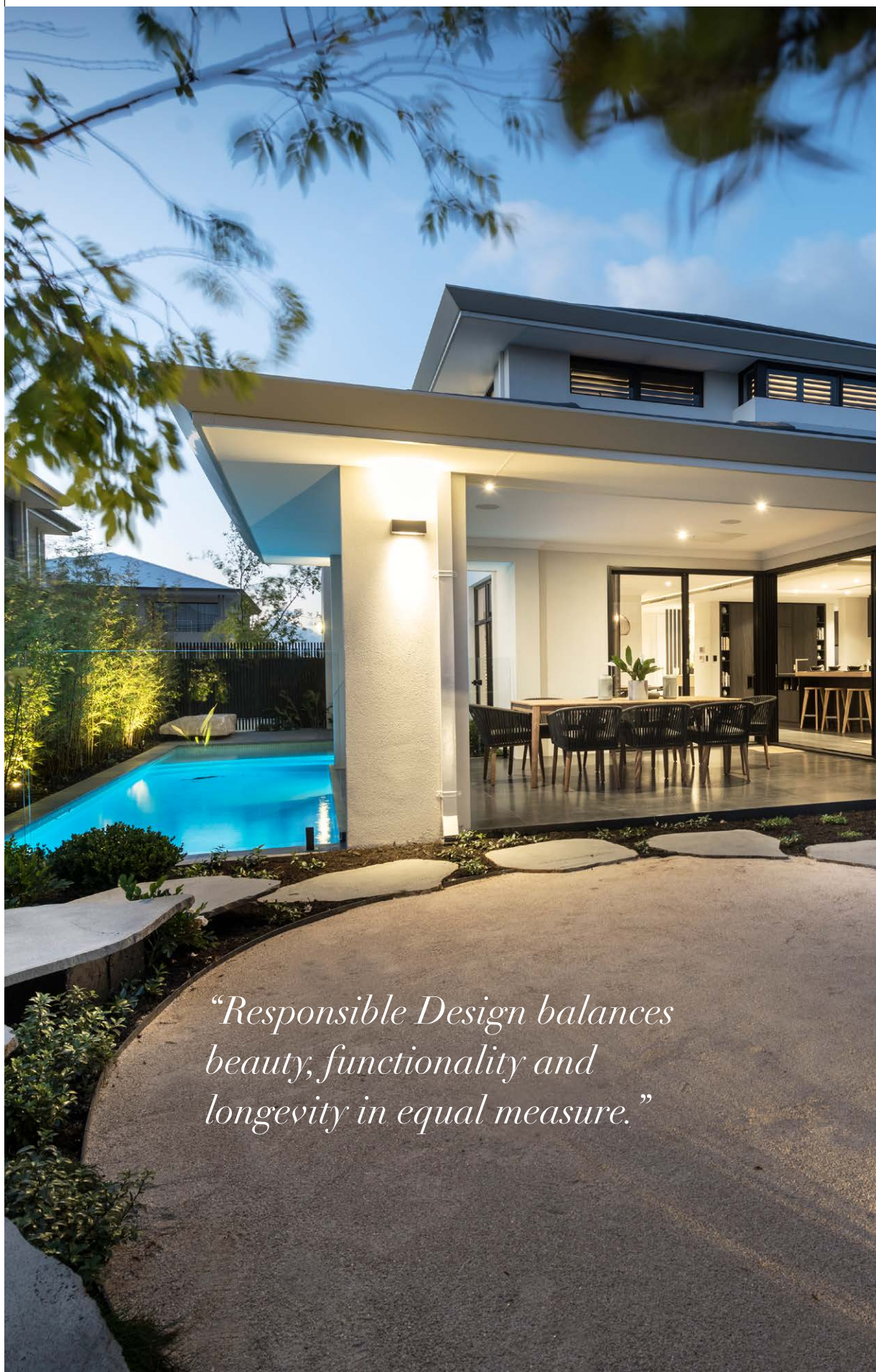


3 CRAFTED LIVING
